*County Audit of Historic Districts and Structures:* Tabled until the Fall.

*Reference Materials:* Chairperson Fisher-Olsen presented the “Hallowed Ground” listing of Readington Township cemeteries as well as copies of all Township National Register applications.

*Whitehouse/Mechanicsville National Register Application:* Chairperson Fisher-Olsen noted that [www.nps.gov](http://www.nps.gov) has a listing of all National Register additions updated weekly. She will check periodically for the Whitehouse/Mechanicsville listing.

*Update of Historic District Maps.* The Commissioners discussed their progress with updating their districts. Chairperson Fisher-Olsen provided copies of the Township master plan and the listing of sites of historic interest from the Hunterdon County master plan to the Commissioners. She also agreed to provide the tax maps containing the current historic district boundaries to each commissioner. Jim Horvath recommended that once the

boundaries of each district are confirmed, the Commission should resolve upon the boundaries at a meeting. Jim Horvath was given Darts Mill/Raritan-Readington Historic District to review.
