Alternate Commissioner John Woodward represented the applicant. He noted that emergency safety lights were required on the exterior of the building. Alternate Commissioner Dandurand questioned Mr. Woodward extensively about the placement and type of fixture.

Commissioner Alan Harwick and Alternate Commissioner Dandurand volunteered to meet with the Mount Amwell Project.

Whitehouse-Mechanicsville Historic District. Chairperson Fisher-Olsen read out a letter from the State Historic Preservation Office regarding the district's addition to the state national register of historic places. She then thanked everyone who had been involved in the project.

The Commissioners then discussed signage to be placed at each end of the district and individual house plaques that homeowners could purchase. Chairperson Fisher-Olsen that the company that had produced the signs in Stanton and Readington is no longer in business. Commissioner Horvath will check on alternative suppliers and request pricing.
