The Museum Committee established a policy that a Museum Committee member may purchase a piece of Readington specific history without pre authorization if the cost of said piece is under \$200.

Nancy O'Malley made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 10:20 am. Rich Grohoski seconded the motion. All were in favor.
